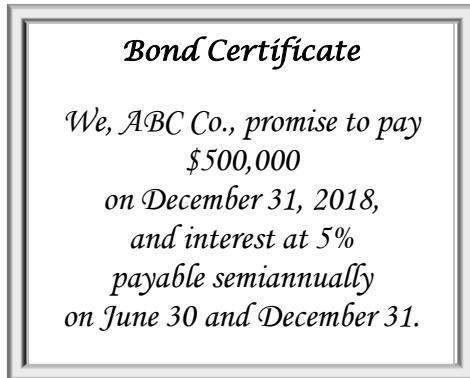


Bonds - Premium Workpaper 1

On January 1, 2014, ABC Co. borrowed by issuing \$500000, 5-year, 5%, bonds with interest payable semiannually. The market interest rate on January 1, 2014 is 4%.
